# COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Port View Preparatory will be utilizing the following daily screening procedures

## THESE GUIDELINES WERE BASED ON:

- Input from several agencies
- Recommendations from the State of California
- Advice from the Center for Disease Control
- A literature review of COVID-19 symptoms



## WHO WILL BE SCREENED DAILY:

- All Staff
- All students, either upon arrival or route pick-up
- Any potential visitor. Visitors will be limited to individuals who are needed to fulfill student IEP requirements

## SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 MAY APPEAR 2-14 DAYS AFTER EXPOSURE INCLUDE:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

**ANYONE WITH COVID-19 SYMPTOMS SHOULD BE TESTED. HOWEVER, PEOPLE DO NOT DEVELOP SYMPTOMS, WHICH IS WHY IT IS RECOMMENDED EXPOSED PEOPLE BE TESTED WHETHER THEY HAVE SYMPTOMS OR NOT.**

Ensuring the health and safety of our students and staff is of the utmost importance to us. If any student or staff exhibits any symptoms they will not be permitted onto campus or onto a PVP route car. Please refer to our sick policy for return procedures.
